

Entry Procedure

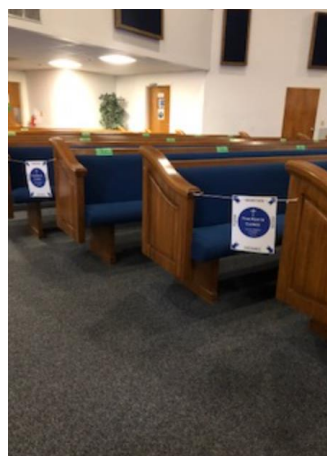
When in-person services begin in January, members and guests will enter the church through the front door marked #1 located closest to the ramp from the front parking lot.



Once in the foyer, Greeters will direct entrants into two lines where they will approach a check-in table so their attendance can be recorded for that Sunday's service.

After passing the check-in table, everyone will be directed to door #2 into the sanctuary.

Once inside the sanctuary, members may deposit their tithes and offerings in a collection box and then proceed, with the assistance of ushers, to their seat for service.



Should anyone need to exit the sanctuary before the conclusion of the service, they should do so through the door marked as #3. Women may use the side door adjacent to this door to access their restroom. Please note that in an attempt to maintain safe conditions, maximum occupancy will be observed in all restrooms.

Once service is over, everyone will be directed to exit via the double side doors, marked #4, or through door number #3 (at the rear of the sanctuary).



Ushers, greeters, and other staff may assist in directing this flow with a goal of maintaining proper social distancing. During inclement weather, the exit flow from the sanctuary may be reduced so that drivers may pull vehicles close to an exit to pick up family and guests.

Additional information may be given from the pulpit during or near the end of services and any fellowship greetings should occur outside of the sanctuary.
